Operated:	All year round.

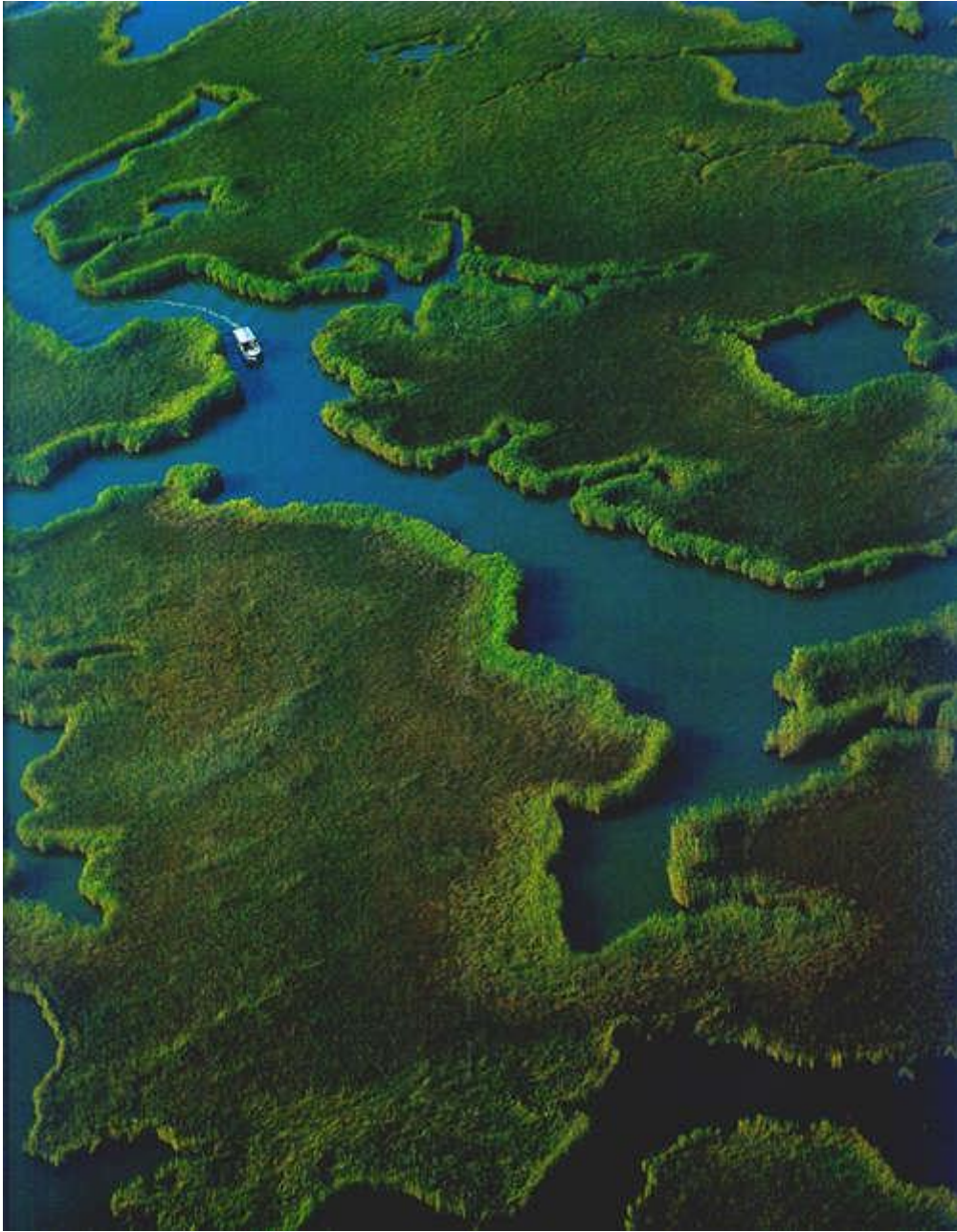
The western end of Turkey's Mediterranean coast is rich in ruins with spectacular scenery offers a special experience in visiting the ancient site of **Caunos** (at present being excavated by Turkish archaeologists). Existing ruins date from the Hellenic period (5th century BC). To explore this fascinating area you'll travel by **kayik** (river boat) winding through the reed-lined river delta, pass the spectacular 4th century BC **Lycian rock tombs**, carved high in the cliff face, and eventually reach a site nearby the ancient **Caunos Harbor**.

The **Dalyan** area is also a unique nature reserve and the home of many rare birds and plants. It is one of the last refuges for the endangered loggerhead turtle also known as the CARETTA CARETTA.

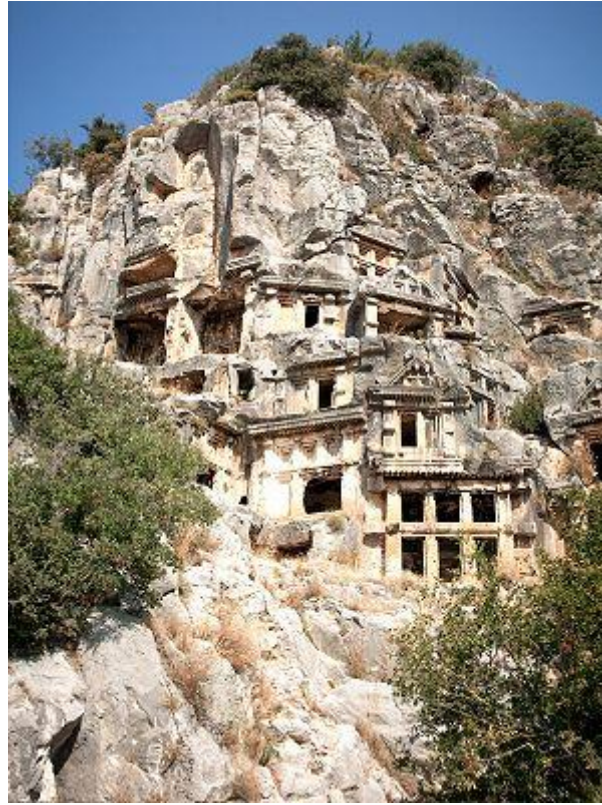
### Program

- DALYAN VILLAGE: Enjoy the atmosphere while having a light refreshment by the riverside.
- DALYAN RIVER: Embark on a kayik (riverboat) going down the Dalyan River.
- LYCIAN ROCK TOMBS: Within a few minutes you will be immersed in history as you pass the ancient Lycian rock tombs.
- CAUNOS RUINS: Take a step back into the ancient wonder world while wandering through the ruins.
- Return by kayik trip to the Delta to Dalyan for a riverside lunch.
- A three course Turkish lunch will be served.
- Depart Dalyan for Marmaris where you will have time to explore the town and yacht harbor.









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
