

## Pamukkale (Hierapolis)

Departure:	07.00 hrs.
Duration:	Approx. 11 hours. Transfers, breakfast, open buffet lunch, entrance fees to the historical sites and an English speaking guide.
Minimum:	15 participants.
Operated:	All year round.

A magical and spectacular natural site, unique in the world, is a fairyland of dazzling white, petrified castles. Thermal spring waters laden with calcareous salts running off the plateau's edge have created this fantastic formation of stalactites, cataracts, and basins.

The hot springs have been used since Roman Times for their therapeutic powers.

### Program

- Refreshment and breakfast stop will be made on route.
- PAMUKKALE (HIERAPOLIS): Around 11:00 hrs you will arrive to where you can visit the remains of the ancient Hierapolis and the world's best preserved necropolis, and laze in the thermal pool on the mountainside while taking in the beautiful views over Pamukkale Valley.  
It's one of the three important ancient settlements dating back from the second century. Hierapolis had once been the center of the religious affairs. That's where this site got its name: The Holy City.
- To top off the day lunch will be served at a local restaurant, which provides an open buffet with a variety of tasty Turkish foods.
- Visit to a traditional Marble Souvenirs workshop.
